The 47th Packard Club National Meet will be held September 17-21, 2012 in Williamsburg, VA. More than 130 classic Packard cars are expected to participate in this special event. This is only the second annual meet held in Virginia, since the Packard Automobile Club was formed in 1966. Packard was an American luxury-type automobile built by the Packard Motor Car Company of Detroit, Michigan, and later by the Studebaker-Packard Corporation of South Bend, Indiana. The first Packard automobiles were produced in 1899 and the last in 1958.
